Ralph Bunche 1950 - Nobel Peace Prize

Bunche returned to the United States and a hero's parade in New York City Los Angeles declared a "Ralph Bunche Day" He was honored by the NAACP in 1949, received over thirty honorary degrees, and was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1950 Some deeply held beliefs of Ralph Bunche were that racial prejudice is wrong because it
